Slovene American Club Membership

SLOVENE AMERICAN CLUB is a Michigan non-profit corporation organized and incorporated under the laws of the State of Michigan on June 23, 1926. It was formerly known as the Slovenian Worker's Home Society. Its location and principal office is at Pvt John Lyskawa VFW Post 7546, 6828 Waverly, Dearborn Heights, Michigan 48128, Phone: (313) 383-9365.

The purpose of the corporation is to preserve, promote, share and enjoy Slovene culture with all persons of any nationality without regard to nationality, race, religion or political beliefs through social, recreational, educational and charitable activities and events.

Eligibility for Membership; To be eligible for membership in the club, an individual must satisfy the following requirements:

- (a) Applicant must submit a written application and be approved by the board.
- (b) Applicant must agree to be bound by the terms within the bylaws.
- (c) Applicant must pay in full any enrollment fees and dues then in effect, and be issued a membership card.

Annual Membership Meeting; The annual meeting of the members shall be held in January of each year in the state of Michigan. At each annual meeting, board members shall be elected and any other business shall be transacted that may come before the meeting. Quarterly meetings will be held as needed.

Special Meetings; Special meetings of the members may be called by the board or by the president. Such meetings shall also be called by the president or corresponding secretary at the written request of not less than 10 percent of the members.

Place of Meetings; All membership meetings shall be held at the club's physical location or at any other place determined by the board within the state of Michigan and stated in the notice of the meeting.

Notice of Meetings; Except as otherwise provided by statute, written notice of the time, place, and purposes of a membership meeting shall be given not less than 10 days nor more than 60 days before the date of the meeting. Notice shall be given either personally or by mail or posting at the club to each member of record entitled to vote at the meeting at his or her last address as it appears in the records of the club. Alternatively, notice may be published in the club's newsletter, provided that the newsletter is published at least semiannually and is mailed to the members entitled to vote at the meeting not less than 10 days or more than 60 days before the date of the meeting.
